## Healings

Jenya Latinin, one of our missionaries and son-in-law of the director of Teen Challenge, had contracted HIV during his years of drug addiction. Approximately six months ago he had to be hospitalized after various tests reported that his T-cell count went down to 4. (A healthy person has a count of 800-1,000.) The doctors diagnosed that he also had tuberculosis in his lungs and would not live long due to his low immunity. The church began to pray and fast for his healing. The



doctors prescribed extremely strong medicine, and said if his liver doesn't fail it will be a miracle. After two months his count is now up to 184 and there is no trace of tuberculosis. The Head doctor of the hospital said that in all of his years of practicing, only once before has he seen someone recover as Jenya did. During his stay in the TB hospital, Jenya led many people to Christ right before they died of AIDS. Please pray that God will continue to use Jenya as he continues to minister there on a regular basis.



During his life of drug addiction, Vanya Novikov contracted opisthorchiasis, a condition in which 30% of his liver was destroyed. After graduating from Teen Challenge he went to the hospital for tests. X rays showed holes in his liver, and that his liver started producing poison that was being poured into his blood. Before he began treatments in a special liver hospital in another city, he was tested again and there was no trace of opisthorchiasis. Because of much prayer of his friends, his liver looked as if he had never been using drugs or had ever been sick before. Praise God that there is now no trace of this disease in his liver!

Alexay Balandin, a graduate and worker from Teen Challenge, was diagnosed in 2009 with HIV and Hepatitis C. The medicine available to treat Hepatitis C is extremely expensive and unaffordable by most people in Russia. He was studying an inductive Bible study course on the Names of God and was moved to learn that one of God's Name's is Jehovah Rapha, the God that heals. (Exodus 15:26) He began to pray and fast for the healing of his liver. Recently, he was tested again, and there was no trace of Hepatitis C in his body. Alexay was so encouraged that he is now praying for healing for HIV.
